

Communion Preparers

8:30 Team preparation on Saturday

Fill communion trays with plastic cups; pour wine or grape juice into cups. Change the eternal candle. Check the calendar and pariment. Prepare box if a Baptism is schedule.

8:30 Team preparation on Sunday

Please arrive 30 minutes before service (8:00 am). Place 4 trays on the bottom shelf of the credenza

table in the back of the altar area. Place bread tray, chalice and wine jug on the credenza table in the back of the altar area.

Place stands and baskets next to the first pew on the sides for empty communion cups.

After service bring everything back to the sacristy.

Sunday 10:30 Workers

Please arrive 30 minutes before service (10:00 am).

Fill remaining communion trays and place 6 trays on of the credenza table in the back of the altar area plus grape juice tray (silver).


Place the chalice, bread and wine jug on the altar in the shape of the Trinity (bread in lower left corner, chalice at the top in line with the cross on the altar, jug on the right).

If there is a baptism, put out baptism box.

After service bring everything back to the sacristy and vacuum the around the altar and the area in front of altar where communion is served, in case there are crumbs.

Clean up everything and put it away.

Take left over bread home to enjoy or feed to the birds.
