The Shalom Clothing Closet is a service opportunity that requires NO money just time.

The public is welcome to select clothing on the 2nd Saturday of the month between 10 am – 12 noon. Shoppers fill bags with items. This is free.

Throughout the month the public drops off clothing in the wooden bin at the rear entrance of Shalom.

The Friday prior to the 2nd Saturday, volunteers gather to set up tables, empty the wooden bin and racks, and set out clothing in preparation of Saturday's shoppers. Volunteers often stop on their way home from work to help for ½ hour or 1 hour. This takes many hands.

Saturday morning volunteers arrive at Shalom at 9:45 am to turn on the lights and prepare for shopping to begin at 10:00 am.

Saturday at noon volunteers bag up clothing and place it outside the rear entrance of the church. Purple Heart comes between 12-3 pm to pick up the bags. Tables are put away, floor is vacumed and trash is taken to the dumpster.
